NOTICE OF NEW THIRD PARTY ADMINISTRATOR

Effective September 1, 2022, the Board of Trustees hired TIC International Corporation as the Fund's new third party administrator. This means the Local Union will no longer be providing pension administration services to the Fund. With the transition to TIC International Corporation, you will soon have access to an online portal, where you will be able to view certain information regarding the Plan and your benefits. NOTICE OF INCREASE IN BENEFIT CONTRIBUTIONS

Effective June 1, 2022, the Board of Trustees approved moving \$0.50 from the Reserve Contributions to the Benefit Contributions. Reserve Contributions refers to the portion of the total contribution made by Participating Employers on your behalf that is excluded in determining your Accrued Benefit. Benefit Contributions refers to the portion of total contributions made by Participating Employers on your behalf that determines the amount of your Accrued Benefit. Please note, this change was not an increase in the overall contribution rate. Instead, the contribution rate remained the same at \$12.56 per hour, and \$0.50 of Reserve Contributions became benefit bearing as of June 1, 2022. Thus, the Benefit Contribution has increased by \$0.50 as follows:

Any contributions received in excess of these rates will be considered Reserve Contributions and will not be used to determine the amount of your Accrued Benefit.

EXCEPTION TO THE THREE MONTH SUSPENSION OF BENEFIT RULE

Effective August 1, 2022, the Board of Trustees approved creating a one-time waiver of the three (3) month suspension of benefit rule for a participant who is reemployed by a Participating Employer <u>before</u> the participants' Normal Retirement Date (*i.e.*, age 62 and the participant's 10th anniversary of Plan participation or age 65 and the participant's 5th anniversary of Plan participation). This exception will apply provided that (1) the participant is reemployed in Covered Employment (*i.e.*, employment for which your employer is obligated to remit pension contributions to the Fund) and (2) the participant works at least 1,000 Hours of Service in the Plan Year (August 1 – July 31) prior to his or her subsequent retirement. Please note, if you retire, return to work before your Normal Retirement Date, and do not satisfy the criteria described herein, your pension benefit will be suspended for three (3) months after your subsequent retirement in accordance with the existing rules.

NOTE: the three (3) month suspension of benefit rule applies to periods prior to your Normal Retirement Date. Different rules apply for suspensions of benefits after your Normal Retirement Date. For more information regarding suspension of benefits in general, please see your Summary Plan Description.
